



OVERTON TABLE

Overton Table is named after the town in West Yorkshire, England, a county that inspires Matthew Hilton, with its rugged landscape and history of producing modernist sculptors. The hardwood top is complemented by the cleverly engineered metal leg frame, and the metal detailing running through the centre of the tabletop. Designed by Matthew Hilton for his eponymous brand, and manufactured by De La Espada craftsmen.
