Marcel Breuer was an apprentice at the Bauhaus in 1925 when he conceived the first tubular steel chair. Named for his contemporary, Wassily Kandinsky, the tubular frame was inspired by a bicycle. Marcel Breuer's signature and the Knoll Studio logo are stamped into the base of each chair.
