

RISOM STOOL

Jens Risom's designs were the first pieces conceived for and manufactured by Knoll. Due to wartime material restrictions, the stool was originally constructed of simple maple frames and discarded parachute webbing. Described as good, honest furniture design, the collection helped establish Knoll as an early source of modern design in America.

Dimensions

Standard: 16.5" W x 15.5" D x 17.5" H Child's: 12.5"W x 11.5"D x 13.5"H

Material Options

Frame: Clear maple, ebonized maple or light walnut 100% natural cotton webbing colours: Aubergine, black, dark grey, flax, forest green, khaki, maize, navy, red or steel blue

Nylon webbing colours: Blueberry, eucalyptus, licorice, nutmeg, squash or tomato
