



ROTATING SCONCE 2 STRAIGHT ARM

Throughout the 1950s Mouille designed large, angular, insect-like wall mounted and standing lamps with several arms and smaller, more curved wall sconces. He worked to achieve a kinetic, sculptural aesthetic that evoked a sense of movement in space.

A practical lamp that is capable of illuminating two areas at once. The arms independently rotate while the shades tilt and revolve on their own accord. A dual switch on the mounting plate allows for individual control of the lights.
